Then you can respond to that event as needed

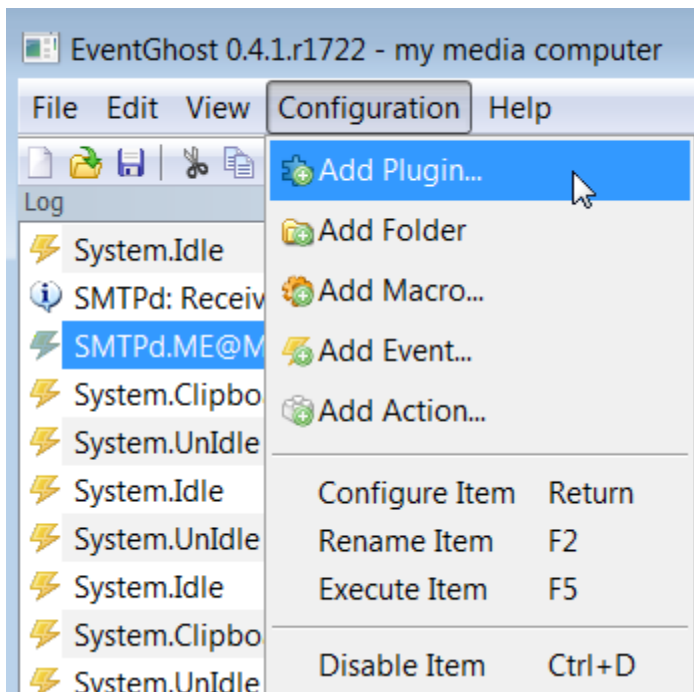
Plugin: SMTPd

Install the plug-in in the Eventghost plugins folder,

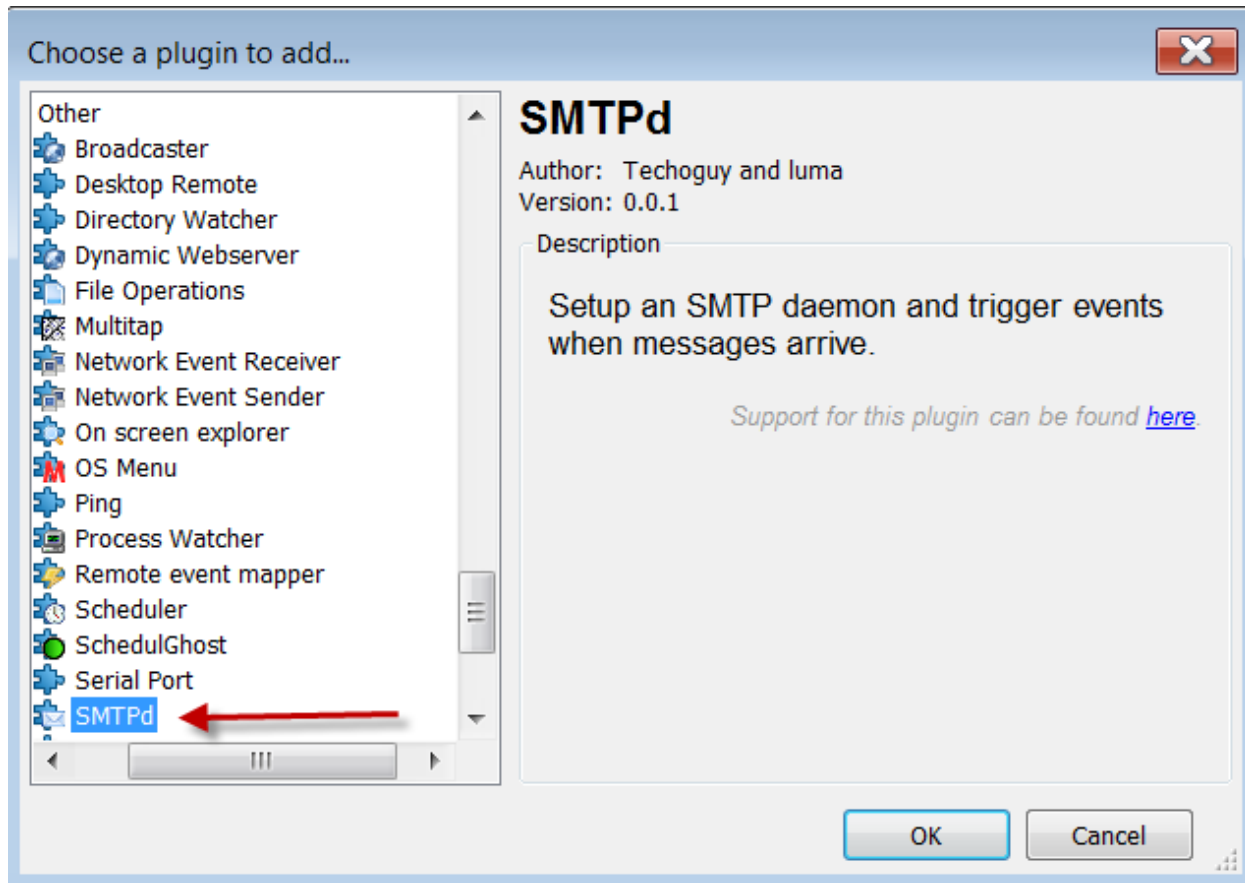
then in Eventghost click the menu **[Configuration]** then **[Add Plugin]**



Scroll dialog down and under the section: Other

Select: SMTPd

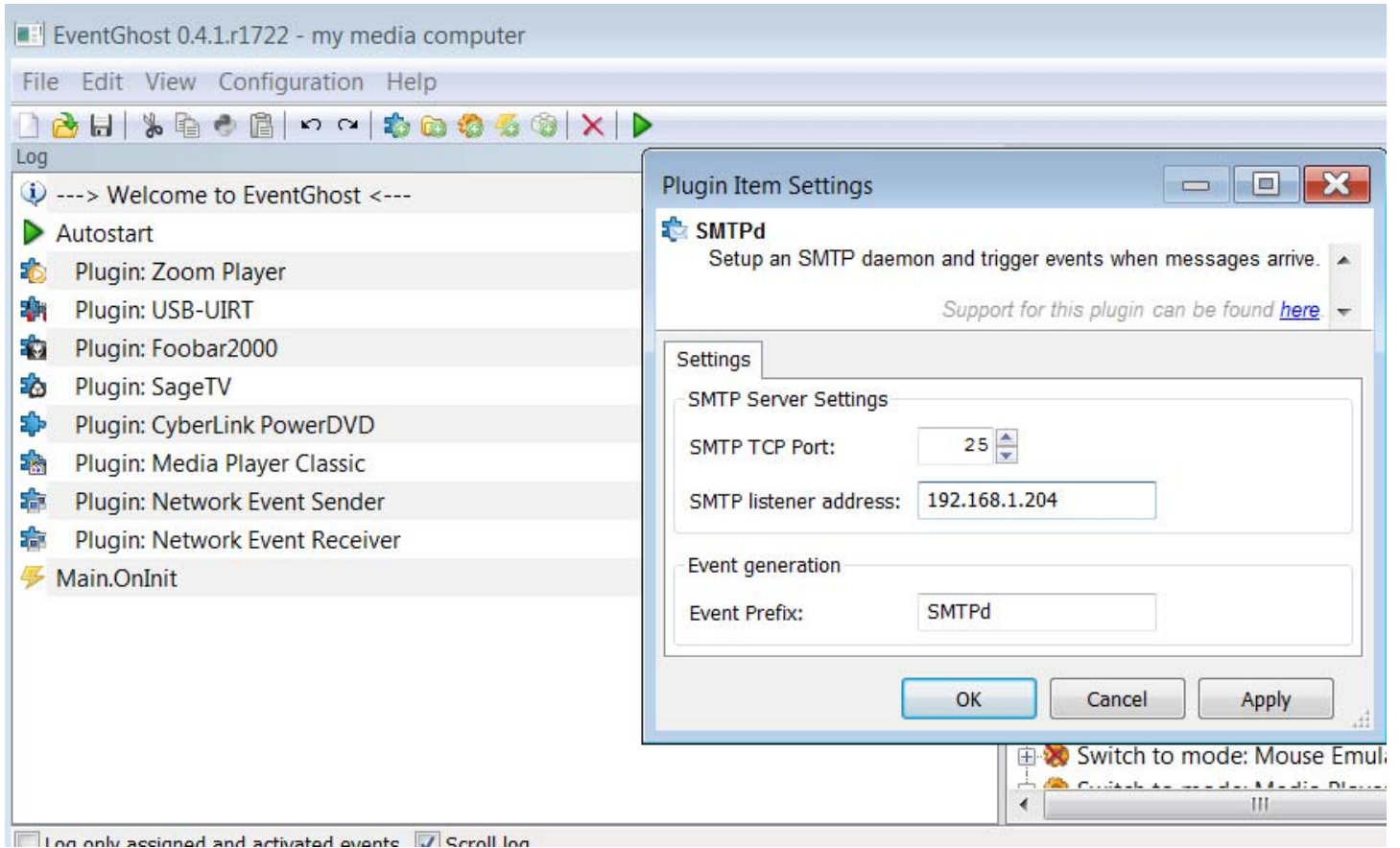
Click: OK



Then you will get a dialog to configure the plug-in, I entered the local IP of my pc that is running Eventghost

Because the device that will send the email to Eventghost will be on my local network

That is all I entered for this plug-in.



Note: I tested this by adding an account to my outlook as shown below.

In Outlook choose: [Tools] [Account Settings] then clicked on [New]

Then the following dialog shows:

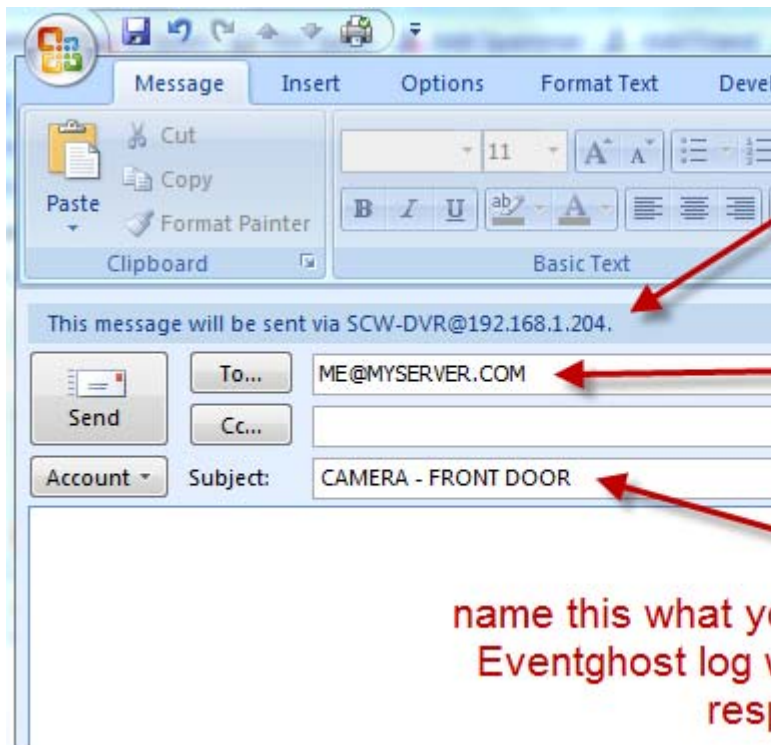
